

## Submitting competition entries



The following rules should always be followed when submitting competition entries

### Print Competitions

- At the latest, prints must be submitted on the Monday prior to the competition
- Prints must be mounted and should have a backing board affixed
- Do not use any rough tape (e.g. masking tape) or any other fixing material that may damage the work of other entrants
- The name of the author, the title and section entered should clearly be shown on the back of the entry in a colour that contrasts with the backing board. Ideally this should be on a label in the top left-hand corner
- If necessary, mark the rear of the entry with an upward facing arrow.

### Digital Image Competitions

- Titles AND image files for Projected Image Competitions must be emailed to the Competition Secretary by midnight the Thursday prior to the competition.
- The email must state in which section each of the titles is being entered
- The titles must also be included within the EXIF data for each image
